Donation Room/ Boutique

Position:

- Washing, Folding and sorting clothing and linen donations.
- Neatly organizing household goods and other items.
- Sorting through large donations to determine desirable and unusable donations.
- Removing unwanted or unusable donations.
- Putting together Household Items for clients moving out.
- Keeping & replenishing inventory on donations.
- Sort incoming donations and prepare items for the boutique, including sorting, hanging, sizing, and pricing.
- Assists with store layout & merchandise displays.

Time Commitment:

Minimum 4 hours per week between the hours of 8:30 AM and 8:30 PM. Three months - One year commitment.

Skills Needed:

Sensitivity to and concern for women and children in crisis; excellent organizational skills; dependability; ability to handle more than one task at a time.

Training Required:

All direct service volunteers are required to complete our comprehensive domestic violence training.
