Child Enrichment Program

Position:

- Work with staff to implement meaningful and engaging activities, projects, games, and crafts for our young residents.
- Provide homework help and tutoring support to children from kindergarten to high school during school year.
- Provide respite childcare for 1-3 hours, while children's parents are attending meetings or appointments.
- Lead fun activities with children in our programs.
- Assist with parenting group.
- Assist with the upkeep of the children's space.

Time Commitment:

Minimum 4 hours per week between the hours of 8:30 AM and 8:30 PM. Six months - One year commitment.

Skills Needed:

Sensitivity to and concern for women and children in crisis; enjoys children and works well with them; dependability; maturity and good judgment; strong interpersonal skills; ability to listen without judging or advising.

Training Required:

All direct service volunteers are required to complete our comprehensive domestic violence training.
